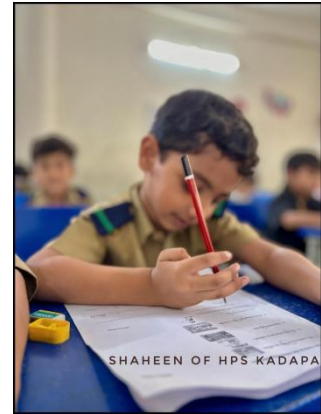

One-on-One Interaction with Teachers & Students Qualified for IIT Hyderabad Initiative

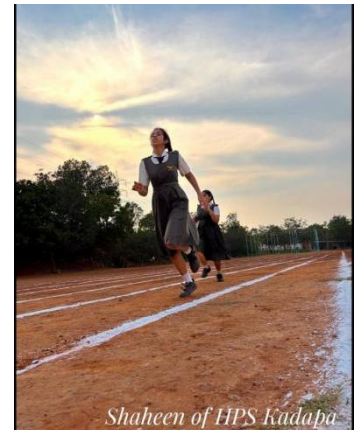

November 17th

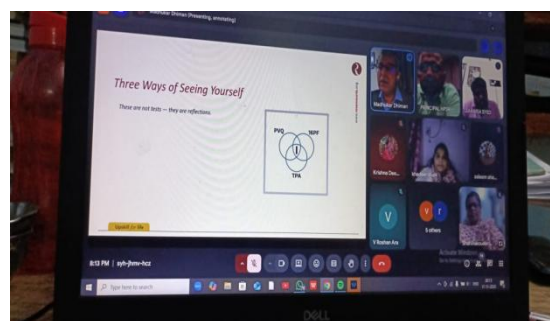
Quarter Final Test for Students on Spell Bee & Math Bee

IEO Examination 2025

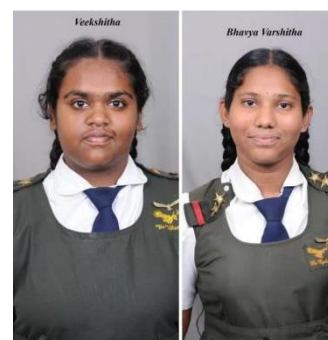
