A proud tribute to the language that has given the world poets, scholars, and reformers! 📖 🌸

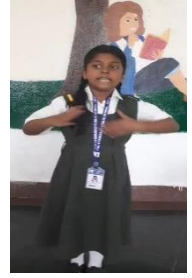
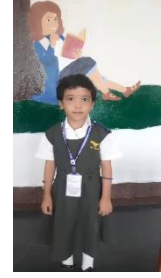
INTER-HOUSE STORYTELLING COMPETITION – RESULTS
